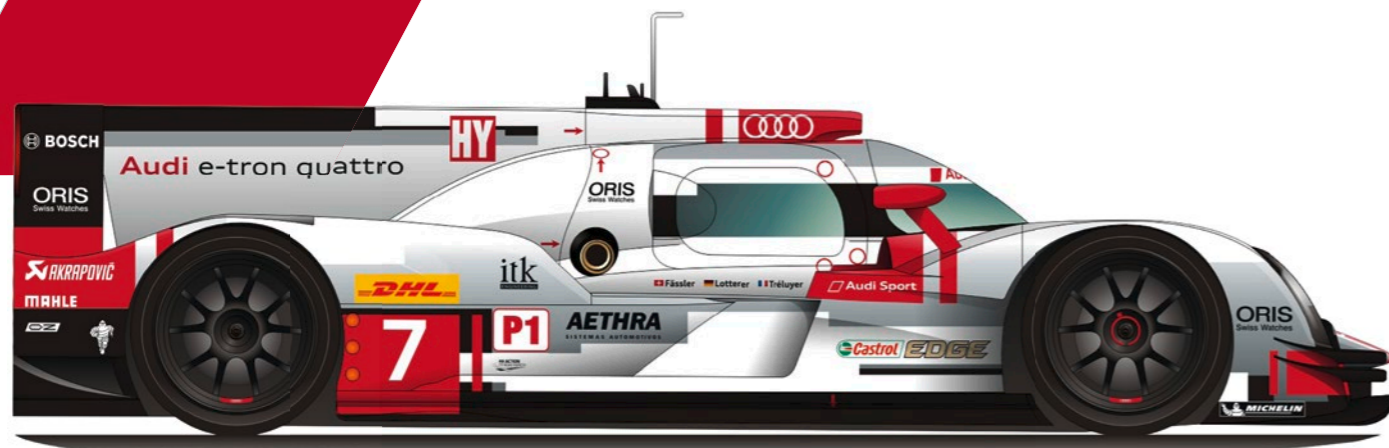

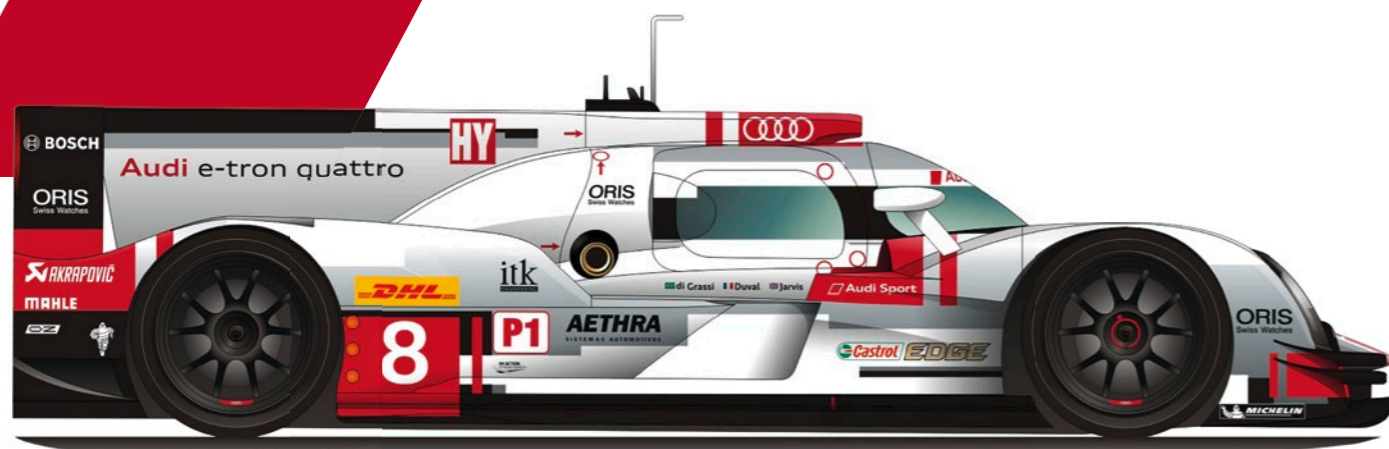

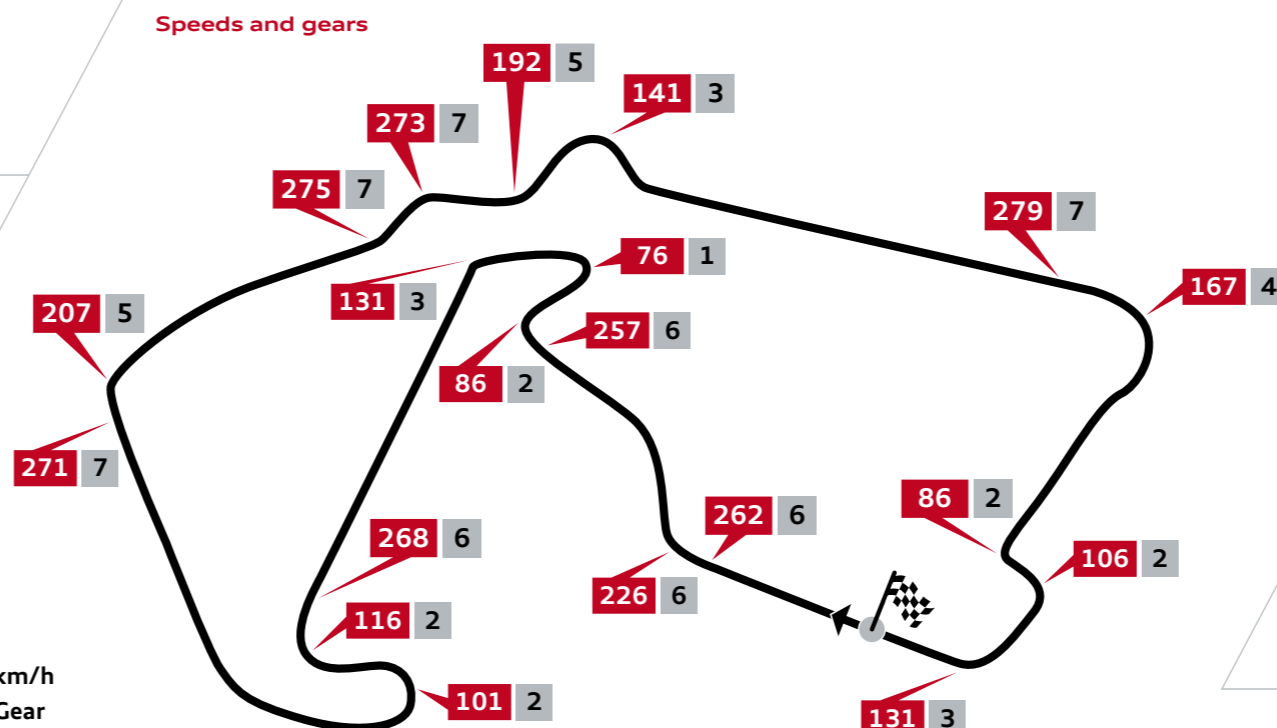

For the third time in a row Silverstone is venue of the WEC season opener. Since 2013, the WEC race winner at Silverstone has been immortalized on the famous "Tourist Trophy", one of the world's most legendary motorsport trophies, which has been awarded since 1905.
